Card 10 - Volcano Report

What is a volcano?

A volcano is typically a mountain or hill that has a crater through which lava and gas have erupted.

Do all volcanos erupt?

All volcanos have erupted or will erupt at some point; however, over time some volcanos become extinct and will never erupt again - like Arthur's Seat in Edinburgh.

Do volcanos ever kill people?

Volcanos can be deadly, although scientists are much more able to predict eruptions and save people now. The eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in 79A.D. is thought to have killed over 16,000 people in the Roman city of Pompeii. The volcano is still active to this day.

Spelling pattern:

This week, we are looking at the prefix 'un'.

- A **prefix** is a letter or letters added to the start of a word to change its meaning.
- 'Un' means 'not'. When added (as a prefix) it will give the word the opposite meaning.

For example:

unhappy This is the opposite of happy. It means that you are not feeling happy about something.
