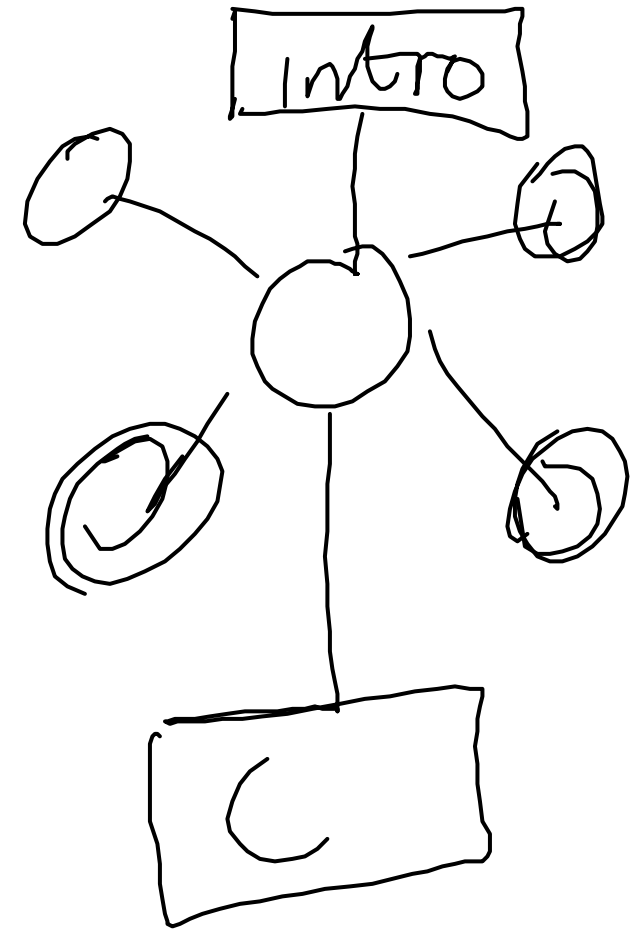

BLAST ENDED SKREWTS


The Blast-Ended Skrewt is a hybrid creature bred by Rubeus Hagrid in Autumn 1994, by crossing Manticores and Fire crabs. They are ferocious beasts, feared by many but truly special and magical to behold.

What do they look like?

Newly hatched Skrewts look like pale, slimy deformed shell-less lobsters. They have legs sticking out at odd angles. They are about six inches long and smell strongly of rotten fish. Sparks fly out of their ends every so often which propels them forward a few inches. The males have stingers and the females have suckers on their body to suck blood.

After two months, Skrewts are three feet long and extremely ill tempered, making it hard to get close to one. They grow grey, shiny armour over their pale bodies and begin to look like a cross between giant scorpions and elongated crabs. The males hold their stingers over their backs, and are highly dangerous and repulsive.

When fully grown, the skrewts are ten feet

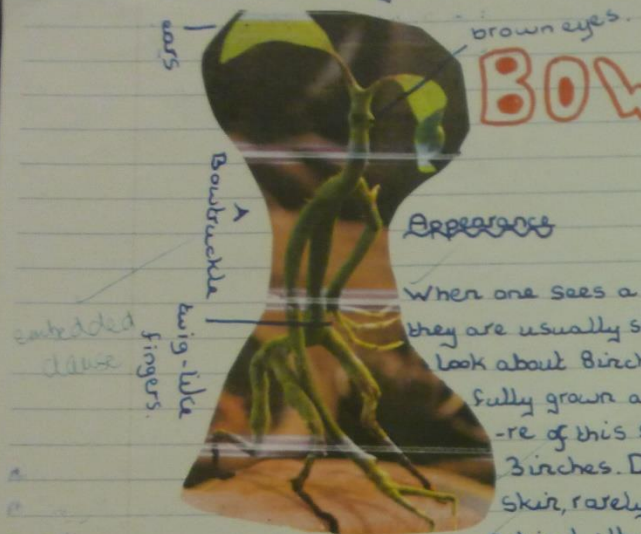


A fully grown blast ended skrewt

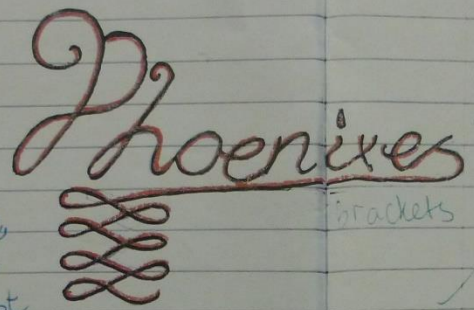

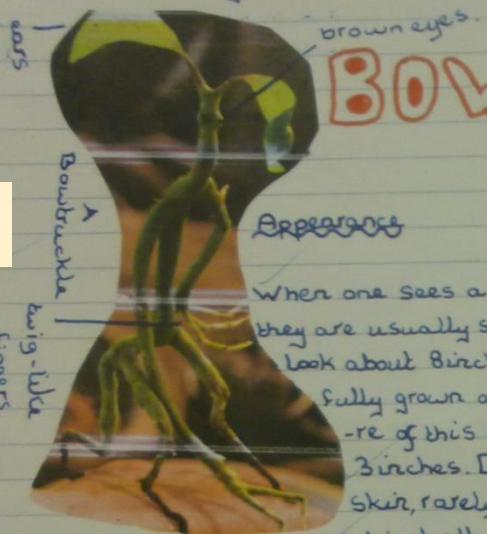

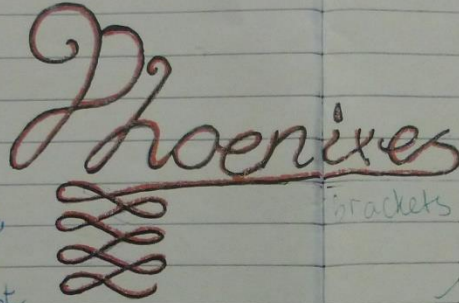
