

What is this place? Can you think of any words to describe it? Jot them down on a piece of paper.




Now watch Mrs Cangiano's video clip, No.1.

Here are some ideas for adjectives (describing words):


magnificent amazing splendid glorious ornate marvellous spectacular striking lavish



Can you write a question about Buckingham palace which includes an exciting adjective? Here's an example:




Now let's have a look at what The Queen is up to...

Now watch Video No.2.






Here are some examples:
