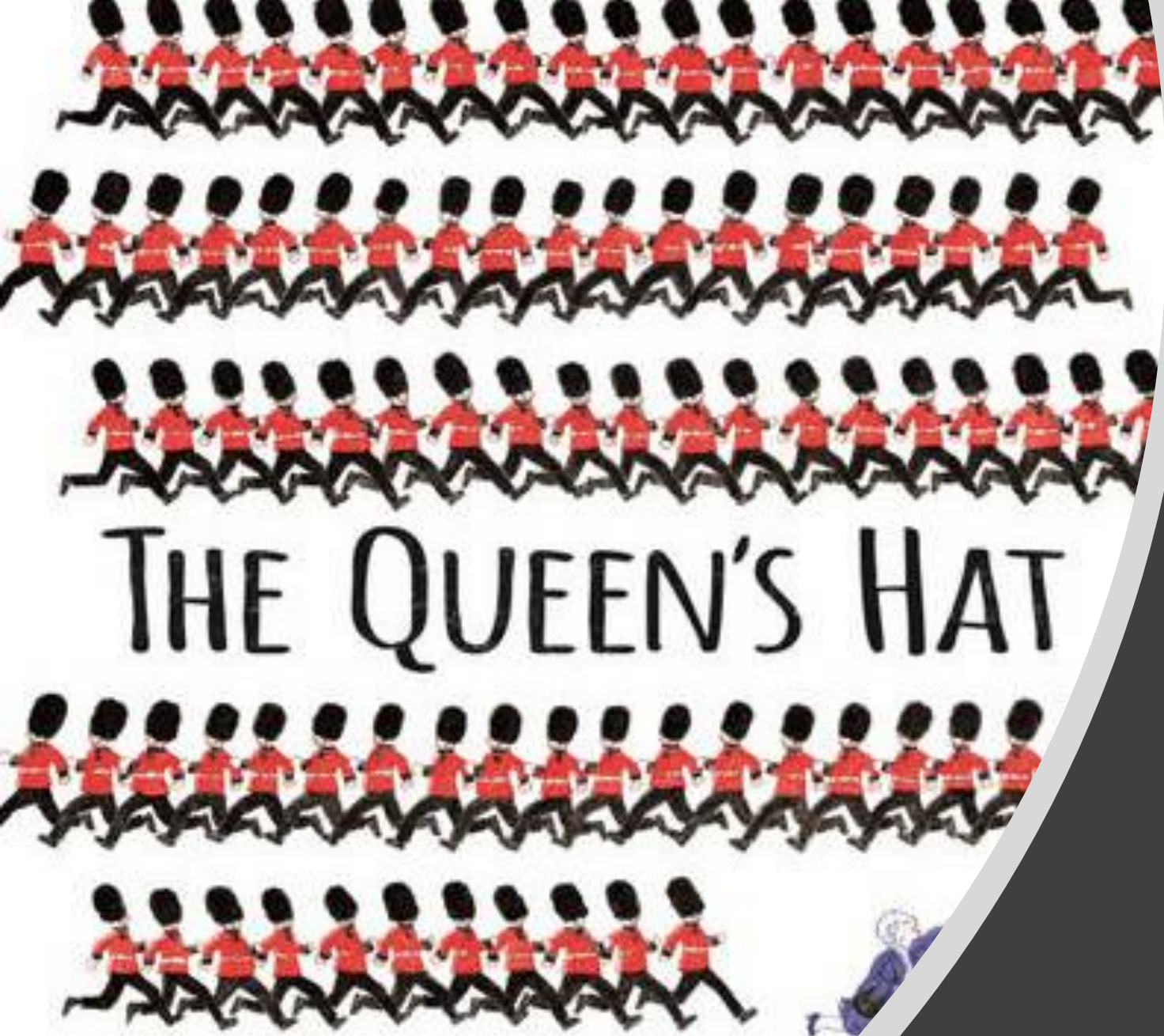

What is this beautiful place?



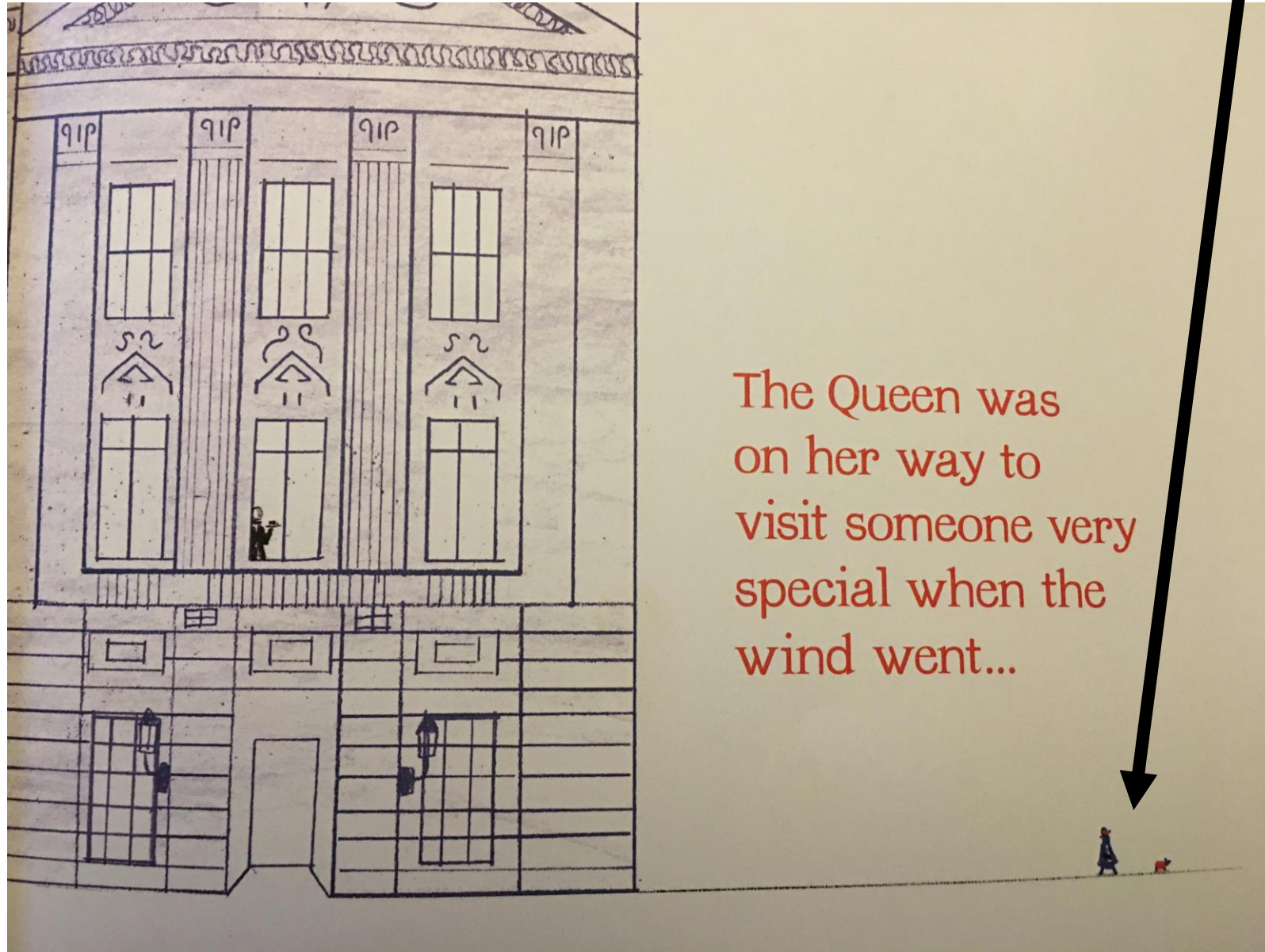
Remember to use a capital letter here....

Now let's have a look at what The Queen is up to...

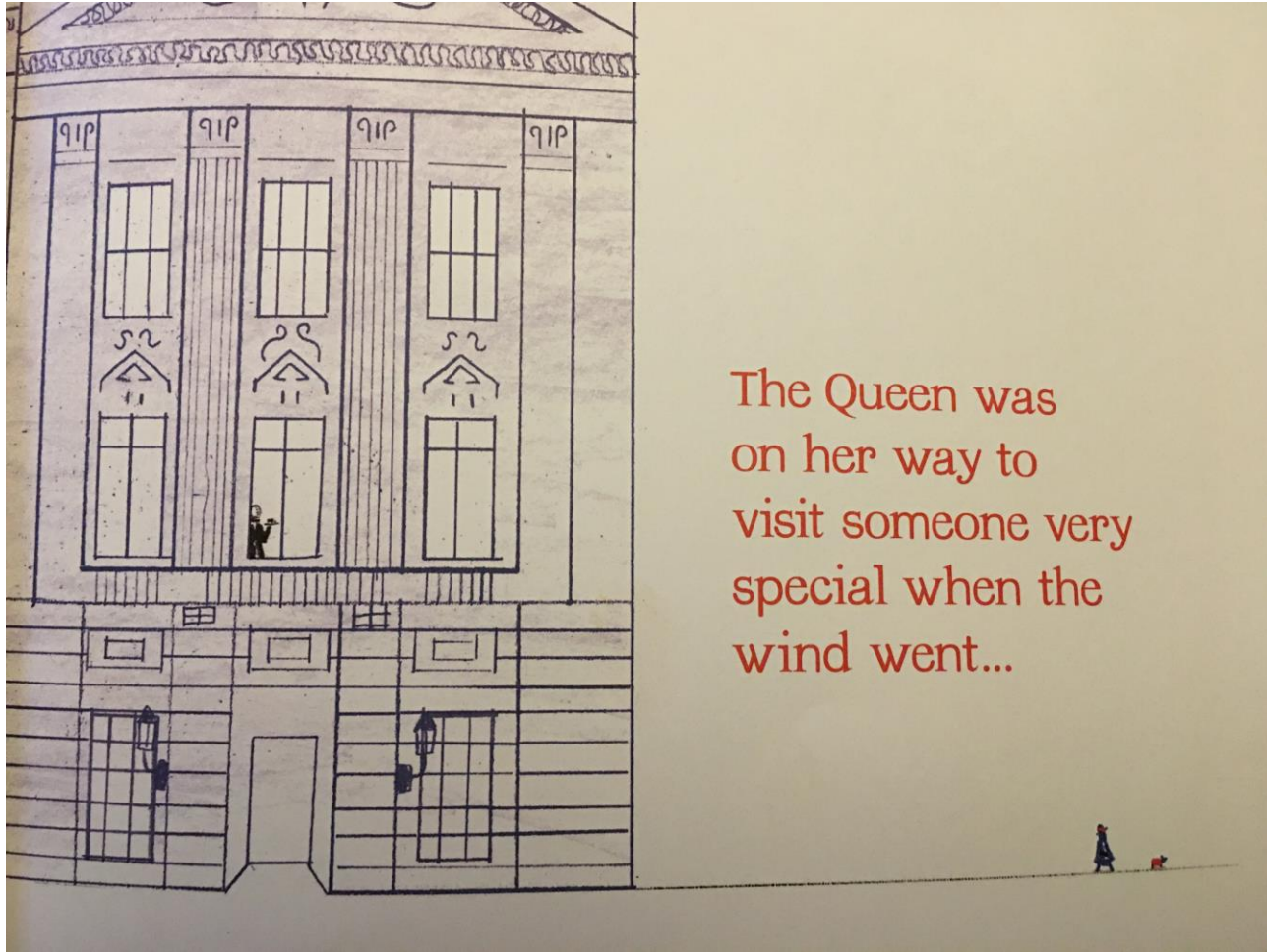


The Queen was on her way to visit someone very special when the wind went...

Here are some examples:

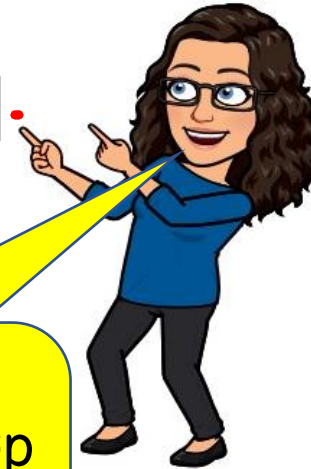
strolling, wandering, ambling,
