Topic: Advent

Topic: Christmas

Focus: Study the role of angels in the story of Christmas. Learn about Christians being messengers of Christ's Good News in the world today and how the Church celebrates the Feast of Christmas.

Fiction: The Lion, the witch and the wardrobe

Focus: Write own narrative based on a fantasy world developing characters and descriptive devices.

Visual Literacy: The Greatest Gift (Christmas unit).

Focus: Write a diary entry focusing on understanding a character's feelings and thoughts.

English – Reading

Focus: Explore Roman society, Roman life, gladiators, gods and roman Myths.
