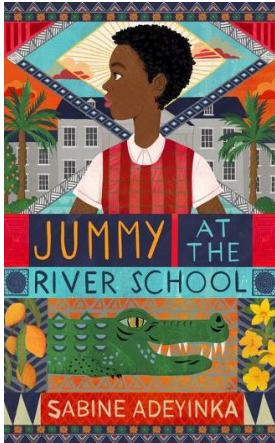


# Spring into a book

A glorious boarding school adventure set in Nigeria - a story of friendship, empathy and fighting for what you believe in.

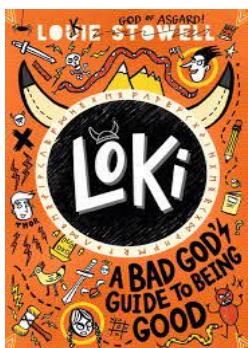

This is a wry, witty and very funny book, written in diary-style and packed with doodles and comic strips. It tells of the frustration trickster god Loki feels at having to live trapped in the body of a weedy eleven-year-old boy.

After one trick too many, Loki is banished to live on Earth as a "normal" school boy. Forbidden from using his AWESOME godly powers, Loki must show moral improvement. As he records his adventures, it becomes clear Loki hasn't a clue how to tell good from evil, trust from tricks, or friends from enemies!
