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


How do I manage my homework?

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At Hagley we use a fantastic piece of cloud based software to help further manage your homework called ClassCharts which you and your parents / carers can download as an app to your phone / iPads...





For example this will show you what you have been set for one day.

When you click on each tab it will then provide details of the task such as: When it was issued, due, details of the task and suggested resources to support you
