## How much homework will I have?

- Look at this current Yr7 timetable. In theory you could be set homework from EVERY lesson. When a homework is set you will also be told when it is due, this is usually the next lesson for that subject or sometimes you may be given a bigger piece so may have longer e.g 1 week
- For example:

1. Mr Neenan sets a French homework due his next lesson, this would be due...

- Week A Monday P. 1 due Week A P. 2

2. Mrs Chapman sets a Maths homework Week A

Monday P. 2 and gives you a full week, this would be due...

- Week B Monday P. 1
