
You've made it to half term. Thank you for working so hard this week.

After you have done that, read through the PowerPoint and work through today's tasks.






Miss Robertson's summary of Chapter 2:

Sadly, Shen realises that the pugs are very hungry. He mistakes the sound of their tummies rumbling for the sound of the snowmobile. Shen is determined to help the pugs and sets off to fetch some help. He heads off to a village in the cliffs.






Key questions:

- 1. What does it tell you about Shen's character that he makes jumpers for all of the pugs?

- 3. Why do you think Shen left to find help without the pugs?
- 4. How do you think Shen feels towards Captain Jeggings now? Why?
- 5. Summarise the character of Shen by picking three words to describe him. Explain your three words.






- 1. What does it tell you about Shen's character that he makes jumpers for all of the pugs? It tells us that he is very kind and caring and wants to look after the pugs.
- 2. How did Shen manage to find the jumpers? The jumpers were left in a crate by his friends on the snowmobile Mungbean and Bo.
- 3. Why do you think Shen left to find help without the pugs? It would be quicker and easier to find help if he was on his own. The pugs might slow him down.
- 4. How do you think Shen feels towards Captain Jeggings now? Why? I think he is very angry and frustrated with the Captain because he has just been abandoned by him.
- Summarise the character of Shen by picking three words to describe him. Explain your three words.
 Kind: He does everything he can to look after the pugs.
 Determined: He doesn't give up and wants to look for help.
 Caring: He makes special jumpers to keep the pugs warm.

Remember:

- Inverted commas (speech marks) are only used around the words spoken – the words inside the speech bubbles.
- When a new person or pug starts talking, start a new line.
- You must say who is talking (e.g. sobbed Paul de Pug, wimpered Puggy)
- Punctuation goes inside the inverted commas.
- Try and use synonyms for said.
