

fidgety:

Adjective

To feel restless and unsettled or move and wriggle continually.

Synonyms:

Uneasy, restless, nervous.

“It wouldn’t be good if Flicker got fidgety in my pocket.”



disguise:

Noun

Give someone or something a different appearance to hide what it is.

Synonyms:

Conceal, hide, impersonate.

“I hung my rucksack on the peg and used my P.E. kit as a disguise.”



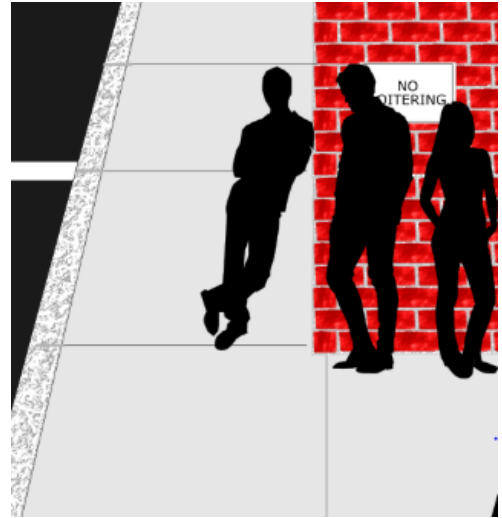
loitering

Verb

To stand and hang around with no apparent purpose.

Synonyms:

Linger, skulk, lounge.



“Liam was even loitering in the hall at lunch when usually he would be the first out.”

dramatic:

Adjective

Something sudden and striking.

Synonyms:

Over the top, melodramatic.



“I told them the whole story from start to dramatic finish.”
