Adverb

A device which does something with little human control or to do something without thinking or .

Synonyms:

Spontaneous, instant.

“My hand automatically reached for my pocket to check for Flickr.”



Materialising:

Verb

To appear suddenly out of nowhere.

Synonyms:

Appear, occur, take shape.

“I imagined Ted, Kai and Kat materialising like my own personal super heroes.”



wielding:

Verb

To hold up, ready to use,
a weapon or tool.

Synonyms:

Brandish, display, flourish.

“We looked up and saw a grim man wielding a hand fork like a lethal weapon.”



sneered:

Verb

To smile or speak in a
mocking, unpleasant way.

Synonyms:

Scorn, mock, ridicule.

“Liam sneered at me.”
