Noun

Hopefulness and confidence about the future.

Synonyms:

Faith, hopefulness, cheer.

“You really have to admire our optimism.”



precariously:

Adverb

Arranged in a not secure way that is likely to fall or collapse.

Synonyms:

Wobbly, unbalanced, unsafe.

“The tent sagged precariously.”



hypothermia:

Noun

The condition where extreme cold causes the body temperature to drop dangerously.

Synonyms:

Freeze, chill, cold exposure.

“We figured being huddled together would probably help prevent hypothermia.”



wilderness:

Noun

An uninhabited wild area far away from people.

Synonyms:

Wild, wasteland, jungle.

“Grandad told us stories about camping in the wilderness.”
