

debris:

Noun

Pieces of rubbish that come from something that has been destroyed or unwanted material spread around.

Synonyms:

Remains, waste, rubbish.

“The man pointed his fork at the ugly heap of debris.”



vandal:

Noun

Someone who deliberately damages things, particularly public property.

Synonyms:

Hooligan, delinquent.

“The grumpy man complained that vandals had been in his garden.”



brambles:

Noun

A prickly, rambling shrub plant.

Synonyms:

Plant, blackberry bush.

“We loaded a wheel barrow full of tangled brambles.”



wielding:

Verb

To hold up, ready to use, a weapon or tool.

Synonyms:

Brandish, display, flourish.

“We looked up and saw a grim man wielding a hand fork like a lethal weapon.”
