Adjective

Something that is easily broken or damaged.

### Synonyms:

Delicate, weak, breakable.

## abandoned:

Adjective

A place or building no longer used.

### Synonyms:

Empty, deserted, vacant.



“I walked down the garden path past the abandoned beehives.”

## poised:

Adjective

To be graceful and elegant or calmly in position and ready.

### Synonyms:

Composed, assured, balanced.

“Grandad was poised to tear up the roots of the dragon tree.”



## tentacle:

Noun

A slender flexible limb of an animal or part of a plant.

### Synonyms:

Tendrils

“He pointed his spade at the dangly, cactus like tentacle.”
