The Rite of Baptism

(abridged)



Receiving the child into Church

The priest goes to the door of the Church to receive the child, its parents and godparents.

Priest: What name do you give your child?

Parents: (name)

Priest: What do you ask of God's Church for (name)?

Parents: Baptism

Priest: Do you understand that it will be your duty to bring your child up in

the faith, in line with God's commandments?

Parents: We do.

The priest asks the godparents

Priest: Are you ready to help the parents of this child in their duty as

Christian parents?

Godparents: We are.

The priest turns to the child.

Priest: (Name), the Christian community welcomes you with great joy. I claim

you for Christ by the sign of the cross.

The priest traces the cross on the child's forehead.

The Word of God



The gospel is read, followed by a homily.
Bidding prayers are read, welcoming the child into the Church.

Celebration of the Sacrament

The priest, parents and godparents go to the font.

The priest blesses the baptismal water.

Priest: Lord, you have called your child, (name), to this cleansing water that they may share in the faith of your Church and have eternal life.

The priest turns to the parents and godparents.

Priest: You have come to present this child for baptism; you must now renew

your own baptismal vows.

Do you reject Satan?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

Priest: And all his works?

Parents and Godparents: We do. Priest: And all his empty promises?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

Priest: Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and

earth?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

Priest: Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

Priest: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body,

and life everlasting?

Parents and Godparents: We do.

Priest: This is our faith and the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess

it, in Christ Jesus our Lord.

All: Amen.

<u>Baptism</u>:

The priest and family step to the font. The priest baptises the child, saying **Priest**: (Name), I baptise you in the name of the Father,

He pours water on the child's head.

...and of the Son,

He pours water again.

...and of the Holy Spirit.

He pours water for the third time.

Anointing with Chrism:

Priest: The Lord now anoints you with the chrism of salvation, as Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet and King.

All: Amen.

The priest anoints the child on the head with the chrism, in silence.

Clothing with white garment:

Priest: (Name), you have clothed yourself in Christ. This white garment is outward sign of your Christian dignity.

All: Amen.

The white garment is put on the child.

The lighted candle:

The priest takes the Paschal candle and the godfather lights the child's candle from it.

Priest: Parents and godparents, this light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly. May this child keep the flame of faith alive in their heart.
