SUBJECT	<b>** Times Tables Multiplication Check – June 2022 **</b>
<b>R.E.</b>	Easter Pentecost Church as a Community Special Roles
<b>English</b>	<p><b>Recount Writing:</b> Children will explore recounts through <i>Little Mouse's Big Book of Fears</i> (Emily Gravett), <i>After the Fall</i> (Dan Santat) and <i>The Dark</i> (Lemony Snicket). They study adverbials and possessive apostrophes before writing their own recounts based on fears they have defeated.</p> <p><b>Stories from Other Cultures:</b> Children will immerse themselves in wonderful stories from Africa. Together, we will read Mufaro's Beautiful Daughters, The Pot of Wisdom and African Tales, enabling us to write Ananse stories using extended sentences.</p> <p><b>Performance Poetry:</b> Children will Read, discuss, learn and perform some fantastic poems from the text 'Off By Heart – Poems for YOU to Remember' (Roger Stevens). We will explore pronouns and embed fronted adverbials within personalised poems.</p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p><b>Decimals</b> – Children will read, write, order and round decimals.</p> <p><b>Money</b> – Children will review pounds and pence, estimating answers before adding, subtracting and calculating with money.</p> <p><b>Time</b> – Children will tell time on analogue and digital clocks. They will explore similarities and differences when telling time in 12-or-24-hour formats.</p> <p><b>Properties of Shape</b> – Children will compare, identify and order angles.</p>
<b>Science</b>	<p><b>Electricity</b> – Children will learn all about electrical circuits and test materials' ability to conduct electricity. They will put their knowledge of circuits on display by building their own circuit to create a buzz-wire game. Then, children will use their games to try to defeat a challenger.</p> <p><b>Living Things and Their Habitats: Help our habitats</b> – Children are challenged to turn an 'old industrial site' in their town back to a wildlife haven. They will consider which plants and animals would have lived there originally, before exploring what they need to thrive again. Children learn about wildlife and their habitats, considering how have their environment changed over time and hypothesising what they can do to help them.</p>
<b>Computing</b>	Animation Effective Internet Searching Making Music
<b>Humanities</b>	<p><b>History: Vikings VS Anglo-Saxons</b> - Children are taken on a fascinating journey back in time as they find out about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England and how England became a unified country. They will find out where the Vikings came from, how they fought for territory and power, and how their fighting ultimately led to the kingdom of England we know</p>

	<p>today. Along the way, they will also find out what life was like for everyday people living in Anglo-Saxon and Viking Britain, exploring things such as Viking runes.</p> <p><b><u>Geography: Plants of the World</u></b> – Children will discover weird and wonderful plants of the world as they find out about the flora in all seven continents. They will recap on Spring learning, locating continents and countries on a world map, before identifying climate zones and biomes (and the plants that grow in them). Children will also explore ways in which humans use plants, and much more.</p>
<b>Music</b>	<p><b><u>Developing Singing Techniques</u></b> – The Vikings</p> <p><b><u>Haiku, Movement and Performance</u></b> (Hanami Festival Theme)</p>
<b>Art</b>	<p><b><u>Viking Art</u></b> –With a focus on improving drawing and shading techniques, children will improve their art knowledge, understanding and skills, exploring Viking Knots, Patterns &amp; Portraits of Warriors.</p>
<b>D&amp;T</b>	<p><b><u>Making Viking Pendants and Bracelets</u></b> – Children will learn about the Viking tradition of wearing jewellery, before creating their own pendants or bracelets.</p>
