Hi again Year 6,


We hope you are and your families are well and those who are back in school are enjoying it and those who are continuing with their Home Learning are getting on well with that too.



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




How do I NOT get lost?: Finding your way around Hagley

We hope that the next few slides and activities help you find your way around a little!











The Chapel



- 1. Mass is celebrated weekly at Hagley with Father Des in the School Hall. These are usually held as a year or house group.
- 2. Our School Chapel is just off our School Hall and is the heart of our school. Mr Miastowski is our Assistant Principal in charge of our Catholic ethos and he is supported by our Lay Chaplain, Mr Thomas.











Canopy Area & Entrance to the Hub

- 1. The Canopy is a covered outside area in the heart of the school and where you queue up for the canteen at break & lunchtime.
- 2. The Hub is our Safe Refuge, Learning Support base. It is open from 8.30am each morning before school, at break & lunchtime. Here you could also have some support with homework or use the computers to help you.











Entrance to D Block

- 1. Each of our blocks are coded in alphabetical order
- 1. For example a classroom in D block would be DF2:

D = d block, F = first floor & 2 = the room number in that block

3. In D Block are the:

English Department (downstairs)

Maths Department (upstairs)

History Department (upstairs)













Sports Hall

This is one of our 2 sports halls. We have lots of sports on offer at Hagley, whether in Games or Pe lessons or as an extracurricular activity. It is a great chance to try a new sport or to build on one that you already enjoy.













Entrance to C Block



- 1. Music & Performing Arts are a big and very vibrant part of our school life.
- 2. Lots of you will have been involved in the Pyramid Concert Disco Fever, when you were in Year 5. From that you will know many of our staff & you could get involved again as a Hagley pupil.
- 3. You will study Music & Performing Arts on a rotation (alongside Art & Technology) so that you get a taste of all the subjects in Year 7.
- 4. You may also choose to get involved with the many extracurricular activities on offer here from Mass Band to Dance.
- 5. You may also choose to take up one of the peripatetic music or singing lessons.



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


How do I NOT get lost?: Finding your way around Hagley





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How does a timetable work?

At Hagley we have a 2 week timetable, Week A & Week B. This is because we have so much we want to teach you so we need to structure it over 2 weeks.

Key things to remember:

- 1. You will be registered each morning in your tutor group (shown as AM in the 1st row)
- 2. You will then have 4 lessons a day
- Each of these lessons are taught by subject teachers so you will have 4 different lessons with 4 different teachers
- 4. The thick black line shows when you have a break or lunchtime.
