History	Learning about famous people and events beyond living memory that are significant nationally; know where the people and events fit within a chronological framework and identify similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods; begin to develop an understanding of sources and use historical vocabulary.
Music	Explore people, places and events linked to our local area. Learning to sing and then play the song 'Once a Man Fell in Well' using tuned percussion, adding sound effects, experimenting with timbre and dynamics and using letter notation to write a melody. Christmas songs
Art	Learning about different kinds of nature sculptures and to explore the work of Andy Goldsworthy and other environmental artists. Use different techniques to create environmental art using natural materials including; model making, observational drawing, collecting material, ephemeral land art and group sculpture building Mark making and creating and experimenting with different shades and tones. Looking at the work of Georgia O'Keefe and create art in a similar style.
