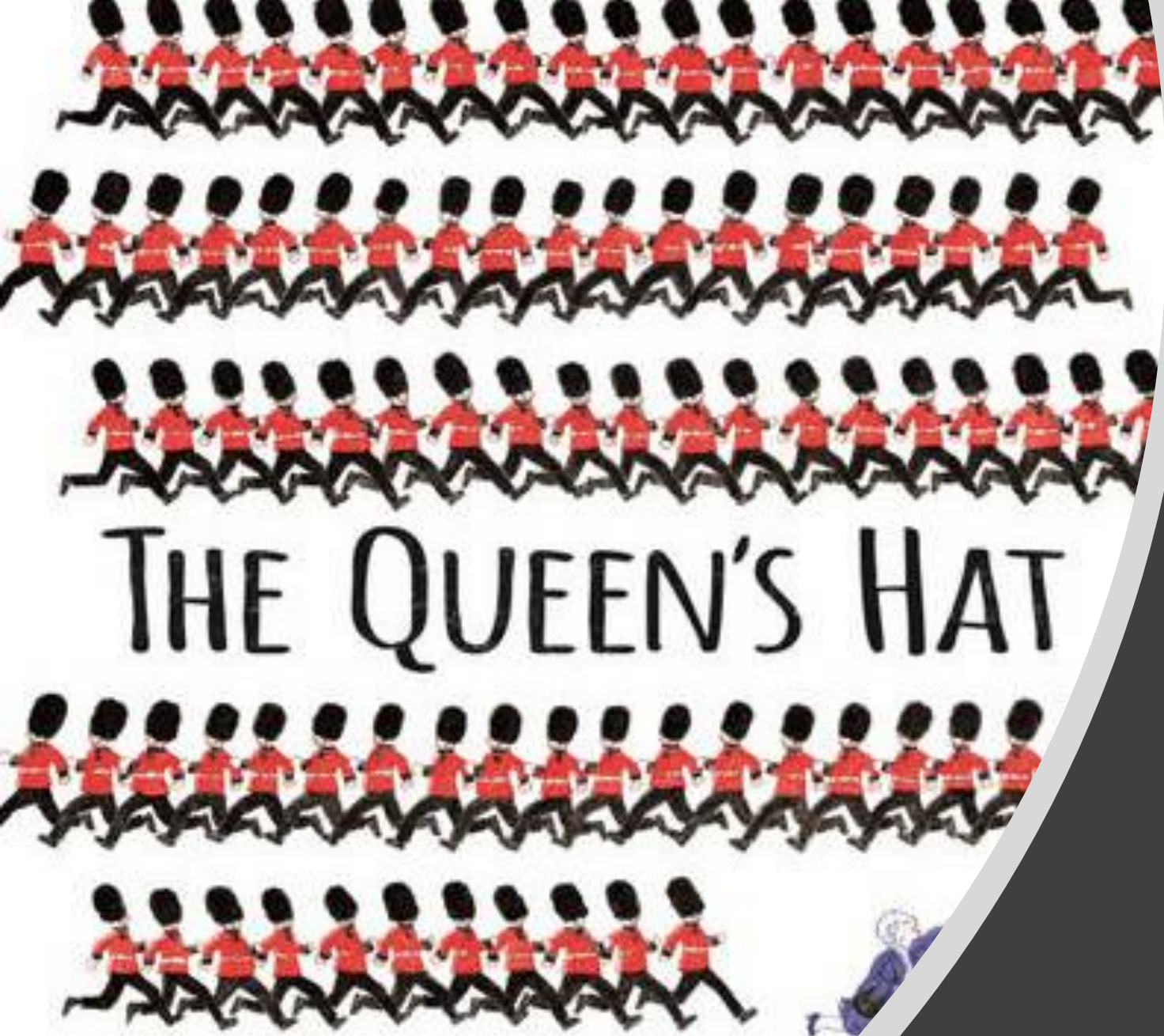

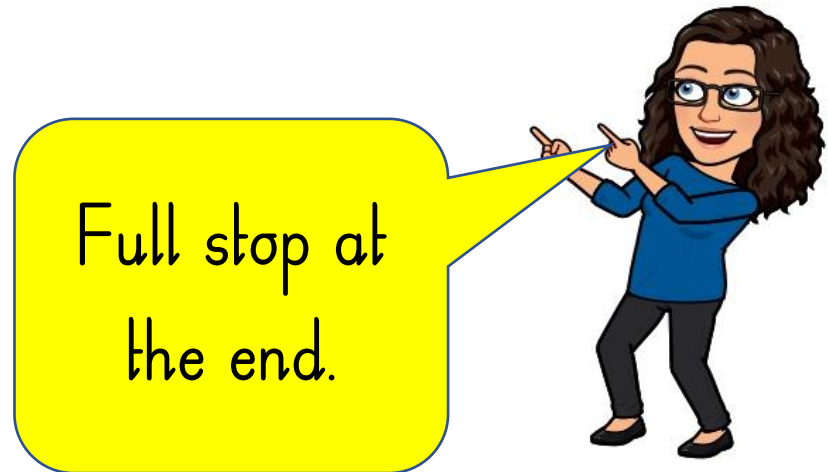
In Part 1, we will be **choosing a noisy animal sound** to add to our sentence. Click on the video lesson for today and complete the activity.
