

## RE

**Topic:** Advent

**Focus:** Explore the ancestors of Jesus; descended from the House of David. Place the story of the first coming of Jesus into an historical context.

**Topic:** Christmas

**Focus:** Study the role of angels in the story of Christmas. Learn about Christians being messengers of Christ's Good News in the world today and how the Church celebrates the Feast of Christmas.

## English - Writing

**Fiction:** The Lion, the witch and the wardrobe

**Focus:** Write own narrative based on a fantasy world developing characters and descriptive devices.

**Visual Literacy:** The Greatest Gift (Christmas unit).

**Focus:** Write a diary entry focusing on understanding a character's feelings and thoughts.

## English – Reading

Discussions, Book Talk and questions based around our class reader: The lion, the witch and the wardrobe.

Along with looking at linked extracts from

Romulus and Remus by Rudyard Kipling, Tail End Charlie by Mick Manning, Ancient Rome BBC Film, Boudica: A Celtic Love song and No man's land by Eric Bogle.

## Computing

**Topic:** Writing for different audiences

**Focus:** Children explore how different font styles can impact a text. Use a simulated scenario to produce a newspaper report and create a community campaign.

**Topic:** Anti-Bullying

**Focus:** Valuing equality and showing respect for others as equals.

**Topic:** Fairtrade

**Focus:** Understanding how our spending affects others.

**Topic:** Area

**Focus:** Understand what area is and how to find the area of a shape by counting the number of squares inside a shape on a grid.

**Topic:** Multiplication and Division

**Focus:** Learn and recall multiplication and division facts, multiply and divide by of 3, 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 orally and multiply three numbers.

**Topic:** Ukelele – The doot doot song

**Focus:** Learn how to play the ukelele in unison including how to pluck and strum the strings, play 4 simple chords and perform a song with peers.

**Topic:** Animals including humans.

**Focus:** Explore teeth, the digestive system in humans and examine food chains.

**Topic:** Settlements

**Focus:** Study the needs of early settlers and how settlements changed over time. To use maps and map symbols to explore settlements and create own map of a settlement.

**Topic:** En Famille

**Focus:** To talk simply about your family in French.

**Topic:** Swimming

**Focus:** Participate in swimming sessions at the Crystal Leisure Centre

**Topic:** Gymnastics

**Focus:** Practice a variety of floor and vault movements.
