Number – Ratio

Using ratio language, ratio and fractions, scale drawings, using scale factors, ration and proportion problem including recipes

Number – Algebra

use simple formulae, generate and describe linear number sequences, express missing number problems algebraically, Find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with 2 unknowns, enumerate possibilities of combinations of 2 variables.

Number – Decimals and percentages

Identify the value of each digit in numbers given to 3 decimal places and multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000 giving answers up to 3 decimal places, multiply one-digit numbers with up to 2 decimal places by whole numbers
