Activity 1: Play Sound Detectives

You need:

some instruments (can be homemade like saucepans and wooden spoons)

What to do:

1. Sit quietly with your family or class mates.
2. Choose a detective to go out of the room.
3. Everyone else chooses a hiding place for an object (e.g. a teddy).
4. Invite the detective to come back in and look for the teddy. If they are getting close to the teddy, play LOUDLY on your instruments. If they are far away, play SOFTLY.



Activity 2: Re-create the musical motif from 'Storm Interlude'

There is a pattern that comes back again and again in Britten's piece.

It sounds a bit like this:

Here comes a wave.

Here comes a big one.

Here comes the biggest of the biggest of them.
