| $\mathbf{2 1}$ | $7 \times 3=21$ |  |
| 24 | $8 \times 3=24$ |  |

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions, e.g. $10 \times \bigcirc=30$ or $\bigcirc \times 3=12$.

## Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day.
