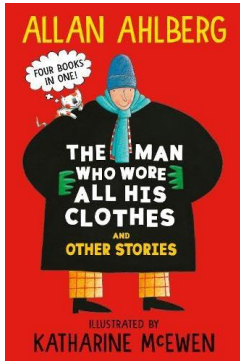

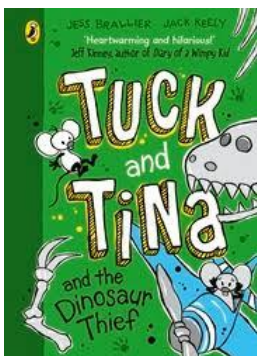
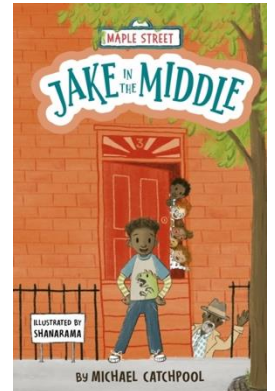
## Book recommendations for Easter

### First Chapter Books



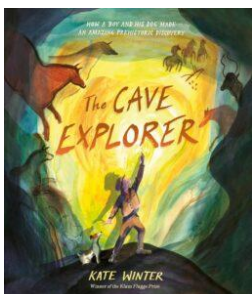
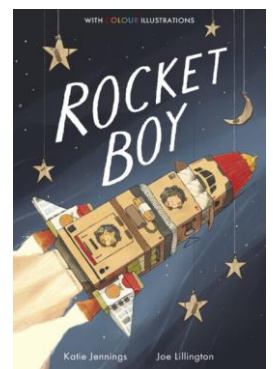

As each story unfolds, everything becomes wonderfully mixed up, leading to a fast-paced, funny adventure with a thrilling car chase and Mr Gaskitt saving the day. Packed with humour and chaos, this is a brilliant read for children who enjoy lively, unpredictable stories.

Jake lives on Maple Street with his older sister Ellie, his little brother Sam, and the rest of his busy family. Jake in the Middle brings together four warm, interlinked stories about everyday life at home and school. From Sam running off with Jake's new trainers, to a favourite toy landing in a rather messy pigsty, each story is full of humour and relatable moments. There's also a borrowed fossil that causes a bit of trouble, and a surprising moment where Grandpa shows off his cricket skills. This charming collection of stories celebrates family life, small mishaps and the fun found in ordinary days.



Meet Tina and Tuck — two unlikely friends ready for adventure! This fun, full-colour series for children aged 6+ is perfect for those moving from picture books to chapter stories. In this exciting story (published 14th May 2026), Boone School is in trouble, with slime dripping from taps and bugs taking over the classrooms. When Tina and Tuck discover a masked troublemaker behind it all, they set off on a fast-paced chase to stop the chaos and save the school in time.

Did you know that the sky on Mars is red? Callum Grant does - and he knows a whole lot more about the solar system too. But he doesn't know what it would be like to see a Martian sunset with his own eyes. Until one day Callum sets off on an adventure unlike any other... An uplifting story about the power of imagination, perfect for developing readers.



When a young boy and his friends stumble across a hidden cave in France, they discover something incredible—prehistoric paintings covering the walls, telling the story of people who lived thousands of years ago. This true story captures the excitement of discovery and the mystery of the past, as we still don't fully understand why these images were created. While not a traditional chapter book, it's a brilliant choice for curious readers who enjoy history, adventure and uncovering secrets from long ago.
