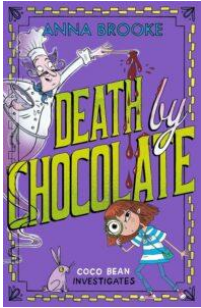

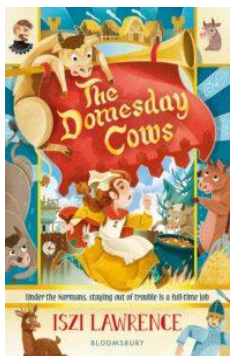
Book recommendations for Easter

Books for readers in LKS2



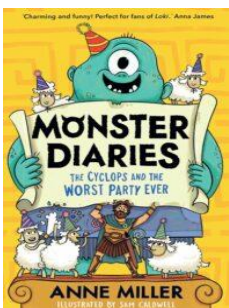
