


Task 1:

Joy and Sadness were both well intentioned, they both wanted to help Bing Bong. Joy tried to distract him and cheer him up by pulling funny faces and tickling him. Often when people are sad we want to make them happy, sometimes though people need to just have someone to listen to them and they need to express their feelings...



Sadness showed great understanding and empathy towards Bing Bong and his feelings. She was a very good listener.
