



Parables

One of the ways that Jesus taught us was by using **parables**.

Parables are special kinds of stories and we are going to find out more about them.

It is important to remember that **parables are stories that Jesus told, not stories about things He did**. We find parables in the **New Testament**. Tell your grown up why.



Parables

A parable is a short **easily remembered** story that has an **important message**. They are stories about **every day** things or events as this helps people to understand them. Lots of the parables Jesus told were about looking after sheep or meeting robbers on the road as these are things that his **audience** (the people listening to him) knew all about. The parables were **quite simple** – there were never too many characters or a difficult plot to follow. Jesus did this to help people **follow the story and help them remember it so they could pass it on to others**. Jesus used parables **to teach people about the Kingdom of God**. Every parable He told had **a message**.




