You can work on these activities at school or at home, individually or as a group or family.




This week, we're going to take inspiration from Swiss artist and comedian:


Ursus Wehrli

Born in Switzerland in 1969.

Challenge: KSI: Can you find Switzerland on a World Map? (Clue: It's in Europe). KS2: Can you name the 4 countries that surround Switzerland?







Ursus Wehrli likes **structure** and **order**. He is also very funny! He takes collections of everyday objects and tidies them up.







Was your prediction correct? How else could you tidy up the fruit salad? Could you arrange the fruit in a circle or different shape?






What do you think Ursus Wehrli will do to this picture? 0




Were your right? How else could the sandpit be tidied up?

How could you tidy it up? What will Ursus Wehrli do?....




Did you guess correctly? How else could he tidy it?

Wehrli made this by carefully cutting out all the shapes (from a print of Haring's art) and sticking them onto paper in an order that he preferred. Which one do you prefer?


Do you remember Andy Warhol's soup cans from last week?

<u>Task I:</u>

Make your own 'Tidy-Up Art'. Find something to tidy and take a photograph before you begin. Choose a way to tidy up or re-arrange all the objects, then take another photograph. **Challenge**: Can you make two different arrangements?
